

While it is hard to believe, January has rolled back around. As a reminder, all students in kindergarten through eighth grade have outdoor recess, so they need to be dressed for the weather. Please send them with boots, hats, gloves, a warm jacket, snow pants in the lower grades, and for the older students, pants that are long enough to tuck into their boots. Bare legs get chilly in single digits or lower weather!

When the weather is especially cold, we do sometimes keep them in the gym for recess, but being outside is good for the students, and we
